- 2. Choose one group to be part of, and let both of your children be in that group.
- 3. Have your children take turns with which group they attend throughout the week.

Bonus/Alternative Activities

Day 3: Foundation of Promise (Watch Video for Content)

*Day 3 content combines Day 3 and 4 from activity book.

Story: Jesus' Resurrection (Matthew 26-28) **Point**: Jesus chose to die for me, and He will always love me.

Worship: Find lyrics to today's songs: "Blueprint" and "Build My Life" in Rally Booklet

Game: Keepy-Uppy! Supplies: Balloon Directions: Keep the balloon up!

Missions: The Italians love their food, and the Worthy family uses this to teach them about God's love.

Craft: Make an Etched Steel Cross! (No craft kit? Wrap a cardboard cross in foil, decorate with stickers)

Coloring/Reflection Time: Color "Jesus Resurrection" and think about what Jesus did for you!

Activity Book: Complete Days 3 and 4 material in your book with your teacher or parent!

Snack: Yum! Oreos are a great treat to share. Enjoy your "tires" by sharing one side with a family member.

Zoom Discussion: Join at 11 AM for discussion! You also have family discussion points below:

Bonus/Alternative Activities

- Water Color Cross Art: Use masking or paint tape to make a cross on a piece of white paper, then paint over with water colors. Pull off the tape to reveal a white cross, and let dry.
- Follow the Plan: Have a leader create a structure or picture from cups, blocks, or paper. Challenge another person to create the same structure!

Day 4: Foundation for Life (Watch Video for Content)

Story: Wise & Foolish Builders (Matthew 7:24-29) **Point**: Jesus' love is the foundation for my life.

Worship: Find lyrics to today's songs: "Build My Life" and "The Rest of My Life" in Rally Booklet

Game: Build It! Supplies: Wikki Stix (can also use pipe cleaners, or toothpicks and marshmallows)

Directions: Make the structure on the card Elsa pulls!

Missions: Food, family, and music is part of life for Italians...but Jesus is the most important!

Craft: Make a paper origami house!

Coloring/Reflection Time: Color "Wise/Foolish Builders" and think about what your life is built on.

Activity Book: Complete Day 5 and conclusion material in your book with your teacher or parent!

Snack: Traffic cones help direct our way, like Jesus directs our life. Enjoy your traffic cones (bugles)!

Zoom Discussion: Join at 11 AM for discussion! You also have family discussion points below:
